



National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP) - Nevada

2024 Nevada NAEP Math Takeaway

In 2024, Nevada 4th graders scored worse than their 2019 peers on NAEP Math and ranked 40th in the nation. Nevada 4th grade black and Hispanic student groups scored worse on NAEP Math compared with their 2013 peers, while white and low income student groups scored the same.

In 2024, Nevada 8th graders scored nearly a grade level worse than their 2019 peers on NAEP Math. Every Nevada 8th grade student group scored worse on NAEP Math in 2024 than in 2013, notably white, black and Hispanic student groups scored more than a full grade level worse.

The rank is among the 50 states and DC for All, White, and FRL students. Representative student groups are reported for Black students in 40 states in 2024, 42 in 2019, and 44 in 2013 and Hispanic students in 48 states in 2024 and 2019 and 47 in 2013.

Gap is determined by the following variances in Scale Score: Black and Hispanic students compared to White students; FRL students compared to non-FRL students.

A 10 point difference in scale scores equals approximately one full grade level.

All calculations are performed to the 12th decimal. Rounding all values to the nearest whole number for reporting purposes accounts for the potential differences.
